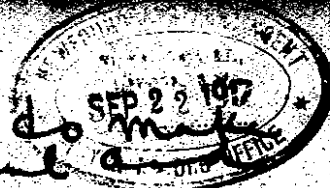

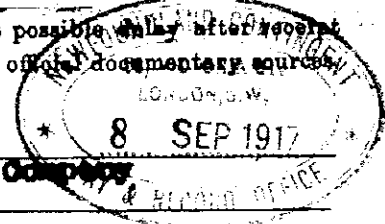

Dear Sir Mrs Robert Bellows has asked me if I could explain to her how she may get her sons allowance which he made before leaving for England - He is by name Stuart Bellows brother to Levi Bellows who left some time ago. Relatives of the other lads who volunteered same time as Stuart Bellows have received their allowance while Mrs Bellows has not received any money from Stuart; and I think she is rightly expecting a month's wages from Levi. I see by Identity Certificate that she is recorded as Mrs Levi Bellows while she is really Mrs Robert Bellows mother of Levi & Stuart who naturally are brothers. She unfortunately cannot write so I signed my name as witness to her word, and am releasing the papers


