I think he was in "A" Coy. at the time of his Casualty, he was clean shaven; he had a gold tooth in his upper jaw which could be plainly seen when his mouth was open; he was about 5'6" or 7", slightly made; he joined with me about a month before. I did not know him very well.

We were on the Armentieres front and retiring from Bailleul about 4.0 p.m. I passed his body before we had entirely got out of the village as there were houses on both sides. He was quite dead but did not look knocked about at all. We passed on.

Dear Mrs. Connors:-

With reference to your enquiry concerning further particulars of the death of your son, No. 3942, Private Maurice Connors, I beg to say that we communicated with the authorities on the other side instructing them to have the fullest enquiries set on foot to ascertain if anything further than that already possessed could be procured.

A reply has to-day been received from the Pay & Record Office, which I am afraid will not enlighten you to any extent. It states that the only information procurable is that Private Connors was officially killed in action or died of wounds on or shortly after 18/4/18 in the vicinity of Baillevul and near Nieppe. It is regretted that nothing further is obtainable



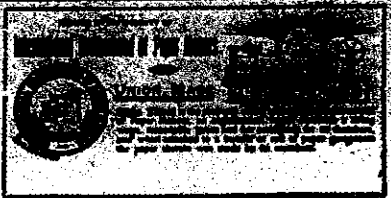

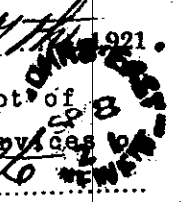
