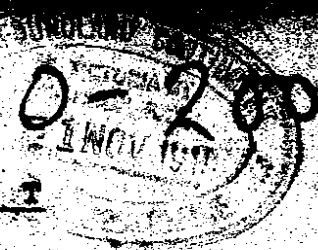



The Map reference as to the place of his first grave, from information on file in your Department, seems to be pretty definite and as I noticed from "Visitors" articles which appeared in the Daily News some weeks ago, that the body of Capt. Rendell had been removed to a Cemetery, it occurred to me that probably by this time Lionel's had been removed as well, as I understand they were within a short distance of each other when they were both killed.

If the Body has been removed to a regular Military Cemetery, will you please have ~~Capt.~~ Nangle send out a Photograph of the Grave as Mrs. Duley is very anxious to have this, if it is possible; and she is constantly inquiring of me whether I have received any information as to the disposal of His Body.

Will you kindly get this information for me as quickly as possible.

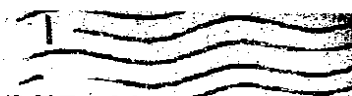
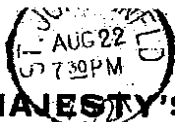
