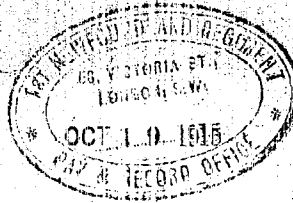

Dear Sir,

I beg to tender you, on behalf of the Government, as well as for myself, sincerest sympathy on the death of your son, Private William Frank Hardy, of the First Newfoundland Regiment, who was killed in action on the 23rd September last.

Your son's name will stand high on the Roll of Honour, he being one of the first to fall on the field of battle, yielding up his life, and, with such unselfish devotion, standing in the breach at the time of the nation's danger. He died for his King and Country, and in the defence of the principles of Righteousness and Justice. It will, no doubt, be solace to you to realize that he did his part even to the utmost, and his name will ever be kept in memory by those whom he went forth to defend, and for whom he ultimately gave up his life.
