Dear Sir,

It was with great regret that the Government received the telegram from the Record Office, London, intimating that No. 998, Private Harvey Hare, had died of diphtheria at Ayr on the 25th May. It was my melancholy duty to convey this intelligence to you by telegram on the 26th instant.

Permit me to express on behalf of the Government, as well as for myself, my sincere sympathy with you at this time.

Your gallant son came forward early at the call of his King and his Country and enlisted in the fight for the establishment of Righteousness, Justice and Mercy. He did his part nobly and we are proud to have such brave young men who so readily respond to the call of duty and such loyal and unselfish fathers and mothers who so willingly give their boys when the call of duty comes.

When the fight is over and Peace again reigns it will be some comfort to you to realize that your boy did all that was in his power towards this end. Though he has laid down his earthly weapon, yet he wears the soldier's Crown of Victory and his name will be inscribed upon the glorious Roll of Honour and be held in grateful memory by all his fellow countrymen.
