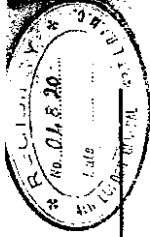

one in a Newfoundland Regiment,
another with the Canadians. I have
heard from neither since Christmas,
altho I have written repeatedly,
I also sent boxes and photos to both
at that time. The boy in the
Canadian Regiment received his
but I have had no acknowledge-
ment from the other.
I thought if either were

wounded or worse, I might have received word from someone.

The boy in the Newfoundland Regiment has been wounded several times and altho was one of the first contingent to leave Newfoundland ("Blue Puttee" boys, I think they are called), has never to my knowledge received a furlough. He was in hospital in England last December when he wrote. He wrote my father at the same time asking for some of his money, which my father in Newfoundland is holding for him, saying he expected a furlough. My father has never heard a word. Whether he received the money or not we don't know.

I don't know to whom to apply to, so if I have addressed this to the wrong parties, will you kindly forward it, as I am very anxious to hear from or of my brothers. Any information you may send me will be very gratefully received. I am enclosing the addresses of both boys, the ones I received last. The last hospital John was in, was I think the Fourth London Stationary hospital. Thanking you in advance for your courtesy, and
