Sent in from Race Course, Ayr. Went to Gallipoli Aug. 1915 till March 1916, and went thence direct to France, where he remained till Oct. 1916; sent home as medically unfit to his depot, in consequence of loss of parts of three fingers of left hand.

In Aug. 1915 he was in hospital in Cairo -- then Malta -- with Dysentery. Whilst in France he had return attack of Dysentery.

On admission complains of abdominal cramps; loose mucus stools -- no indaema.

Light diet. Stools to be examined.

14/2/17. Stools negative.

Fit for Aux. Hpl.

19/2/17. Stools negative on two successive examinations.
