With reference to the documents handed me by you on your recent visit to this Office stating that this man did not receive full pay for the period he was in Hospital, 7/10/14 to 29/1/15; from the attached memorandum it would appear that the amount of pay issued to Pte.Mallam up to the 22/1/15 was £11.5.0, and not £10.18.0 as stated in his claim. Also that the Adjutant, 1st.Bn., received on account of Pte.Mallam £15.8.9½.
