Statement made by 1590 Pte. H, Tulk, 1st Battn. Royal Newfoundland Regiment, regarding his brother 4207 Pte. R. Tulk, who was reported wounded and missing 14/10/18.

"I was speaking to Capt. H. Williamson, MC.O.C. of D. Co., 1st Bn., about two weeks ago, who told me that "my brother 4207 Pte. R. Tulk was wounded during the "attack on 14/10/18 and that he is now dead. Capt. "Williamson has his pay book(A.B.64) at present.

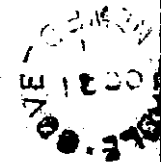
