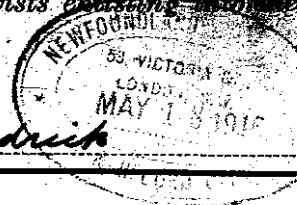

I trust that you may have the comforting presence of the Great Father of us all at this time.

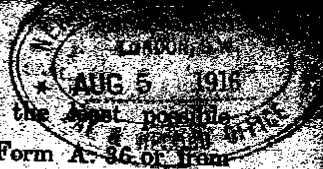
