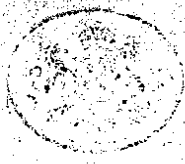

Dear Sir,

I regret to inform you that your son, No. 2050, Private Adolphus Wiseman, who was previously reported missing October 12th, 1916, is now officially believed to have been killed in action on that date.

I desire to express on behalf of the Government, as well as for myself, sincerest sympathy with you at this time of sorrow. We feel the loss of loved ones, but it will, no doubt, be some consolation to you to think that your son willingly answered the call of King and Country, did his part nobly, and fell, facing the foe, in defence of the principles of Righteousness, Truth and Liberty. Though he has laid down the earthly weapons of warfare he now wears the Soldier's Crown of Victory, and his name will be inscribed upon the glorious Roll of Honour, and be held in fragrant in fragrant memory by all his fellow-countrymen. When the victory is won and Peace again reigns upon the earth, it will be a comforting thought to you that in this glorious achievement he bore no small part.

I trust that you may have the Grace and Consolation of the Great Father of us all.
