I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to acknowledge the receipt of your letter and enclosures of the 18th ultimo, concerning the case of the above named widow, and in connection therewith to inform you that authority for the issue of pension under the Newfoundland Act at the rate of \$32.00 per month with effect from 11th December 1918, increasing to \$40.00 per month from the 1st January 1919, plus 20% bonus from 1st January 1920, to 31st December, 1921, and again increasing to \$60.00 per month from the 1st January 1922, subject to adjustment with payments made, has this day been forwarded to the Controller, Pension Issue Office together with authority for the payment of gratuity of \$64.00. The necessary instructions concerning the payment of the above award will be forwarded to the appropriate authorities in due course by the Controller, Pension Issue Office.

The attached marriage certificate is passed to you for the favour of your direct disposal.

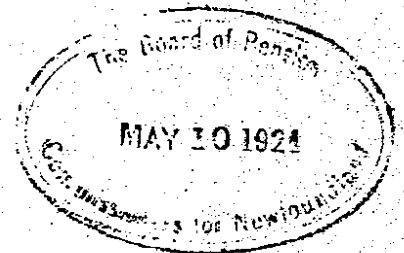
