For bravery and distinguished service in the field. In the attack on the enemy near Langemarck on August 16th 1917, as a Lewis gunner when the rest of the team were knocked out by a shell, he took the gun and two carriers into action, also retaining his rifle and fixed bayonet. The going at this point was particularly heavy. He however held on to the gun and arrived at the objective in time to give valuable assistance to the people on the left who were hung up by a block-house.
