It was with extreme regret that the Government received a cablegram from the Record Office, London, reporting that your son, Private Martin P. Farrell, had been Killed in Action on the 1st July last.

be some consolation to you to think that your boy loyally answered
the Call of King and Country, fought bravely and well and fell with
his face to the foe in defence of the principles of Righteousness,

and now wears the Soldier's Crown of Victory. His name will be emblazoned upon the glorious Roll of Honour and be held in fragrant
memory by all his fellow-countrymen. We are proud of our gallant

gave their boys when the Call of Duty came. When the Victory has
been won and Peace again reigns it will be a comfort to you to think
that, in this great achievement, your gallant boy bore no small part,


