



Under the provisions of the War Measures Act, 1914-16 is is ordered that any person who is or has been a member of His Majesty's Forces during the present War and who has suffered from any venereal disease, and who may still be suffering from the effects of said dosease may, on the certificate of the Medical or Acting Medical Health Officer setting forth the nature of the disease and recommending aggregation be arrested by any Peace Officer and placed in the Military Hospital at St. John's and there detained until pronounced cured by a certificate of the Medical or Acting Medical Health Officer, or the Medical Superintendent or the physician in charge of said Hospital.

Any person so datained who escapes from the said Hospital, or who refuses to comply with the rules and regulations of said Hospital, or any person who aids another in escaping from said Hospital, shall be guilty of a breach of this Order and liable of summary conviction to a fine of One thousand Dollars and in default of payment to one year's imprisonment."
