London Gazette, January 6th 1917

Action Date, October 12th 1916 – Gueudecourt

For bravery in the field. On October 12th near Gueudecourt in an attack on German trenches he showed great coolness and gallantry as a runner, three times carrying back messages through a very heavy barrage to Battalion Headquarters. He was severely wounded.
