The Corporal saw the light and called other members of the Guard to wines it: he claimed that the light moved upwards and downwards during its travel through the air and circled round before leaving their sight.
\#2869 I/Cpl. T. J. Kean reported to me that he saw a light moving about in the sky. From information given by the sentry he was inclined to think it was a seaplane or some form of airship as the sentry claimed he heard the noise of the engine.
