I confirm my telegram of this date as follows:-

"Your letter Pebruary 10th just received "all statements incorrect. This for your "information in event of necessity of action "pending receipt of my letter which follows."

The records of this Department whow that Ho. 3653 Edmunt Perk enlisted on the 90th April, 1917; he gave his age as 19 years. He embarked for England on 19th May 1917, and perceeded for France on 25rd April, 1918. After the cessation of hostilities he was sent to England on 19th Hannay, 1919, and was repatriated to Newfoundland on 30th January, 1919 and discharged on 10th Spril, 1919.

He was not wounded on service; and was not in hospital for any cause while in the Regiment. His service of ever one year and under two entitled him to folly payments of \$70.00 each as War Service Gratuity. On his neurn to this country he had a debit balance with the London Of ite of \$42.55; he was paid three cheques of \$76.00 each and one of \$28.55 which squered his account for \$280.00. On his enlistment he stated that he was unmarried, and gave as his next of kin his father. Hr. Reuben Park of McIvers Cove, St. Goorges.

There is no belance at his credit in this Department at the present time, and he is not entitled to a pension. It would appear that his attachments are entirely incorrect. It cable of this date was put you wise in case you wish to take any action in the meantime.
