Action Date, 30th November 1917 – Cambrai

For special bravery in the operation commencing 30th November. His repeated trips with wounded into Marcoing under heavy shell fire undoubtedly saved many lives. He also greatly helped the men in the front line as well as the wounded at the Aid Post, when on his own initiative he saved and brought forward bread and water under heavy shell and machine gun fire.
