Authority, Daily Orders, 1st Battalion, 28/10/18*

For conspicuous bravery and devotion to duty. On 29th September 1918, during the attack beyond Keiberg Ridge, the right company had been temporarily held up by about 40 of the enemy firing from an entrenched position. Under very heavy machine gun fire, Reid crawled forward to the left flank with his Lewis Gun team, opened an enfilade fire upon the enemy, and forced them to surrender which enabled the line to advance.
