Action Date, April 14th 1917 – Monchy-le-Preux

For bravery in the field. At Monchy-le-Preux on April 14th 1917, when an attack had failed, he displayed the greatest gallantry as one of a small party hastily collected to oppose the hostile advance. This party maintained itself in the face of overwhelming odds, inflicted heavy losses on the enemy and completely checked him on this part of the line.

Distinguished Conduct Medal

London Gazette, January 10th 1920

Action Date, October 4th 1918 – Ledeghem

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty on the night of October 4th 1918, near the Menin-Roulers Road in charge of the battalion ration party. Owing to intense shell fire the party became demoralized and scattered. Entirely alone, he dressed the wounded and collected the rations while the bombardment was on, ultimately delivering them all to their respective companies.
