Action date, December 3rd, 1917 – Masniernes

A Battalion Runner who is always ready to do his duty, showing utter disregard of danger. On the morning 3rd December 1917, at Masniernes, when the wires were out, he went to Brigade Headquarters, with messages 8 times under heavy shell fire and machine gun fire. He helped to bring up rations, the whole time without rest. He showed very great bravery, and was always the first to come forward to take messages regardless of danger. At all times in the front line he has shown himself to be a very trustworthy and excellent runner.
