

Extract of Dr. W. F. Lloyd,
Minister of Justice,

(Original in 2471 Osbourne) October 25, 1917.

This man enlisted in the Forestry Companies on May 17th, his medical report shows, that he took ill about a week after enlisting, was ill eighteen days, on duty for one week, again ill for eleven days, on being questioned he stated that he had had a similiar attack of Myalgia about two years ago, he is a healthy young man, except for pains in the muscels of thigh, sometimes also in ankles and arms, he was before Standing Medical Board, who recommended that he be discharged as unfit for Forestry work. They also have certified that his disability is not due to, no'r has it been aggravated by Military Service.*
