Will you look up his papers and have same reviewed by the Medical Officer in order that it may be ascertained whether it is likely that Sgt. Winter will be found unfit for General Service. In this case arrangements might be made through the Dam. To have him boarded at New York, in order to ascertain whether any pensionable disability exists.

If it is considered that he would be fit for General Service, he could be granted conditional leave under the usual conditions. His discharge to be confirmed when final demobilization orders are received.

Will you write Sgt. Winter advising him of the position, and instructing him that it will be in order to take up civilian employment, subject to the regulations.


